Terms and conditions

- 1. This small grant scheme is operated by the Exelby Green Dragon Community Pub Co Ltd. Full acknowledgement of funding must be given in any publicity etc.
- 2. The scheme provides for small grants of up to £75 to assist with one off (capital) expenditure to support clubs, organisations or individuals who undertake a community-based activity in or around Exelby and using the Exelby Green Dragon pub or café as a community hub
- 3. There is only a small total amount of funding available so not all applications will be successful. The fund is toped up as fund raising or opportunities permit.
- 4. Whilst there are no restrictions on the type of application that may be made, preference will be given to such as the purchase of equipment or resources that benefits members of a group or organisation that provides a community-based activity.
- 5. It may be possible for the Exelby Green Dragon Pub Co ltd to purchase equipment on behalf of an organisation or group. If so, the grant amount can be up to £75 + vat. Any such equipment will always remain in the ownership of the Pub Co and in effect will be on permanent loan. A separate loan agreement may be required. The applicant must still state who will be responsible for the equipment and its maintenance in the application.
