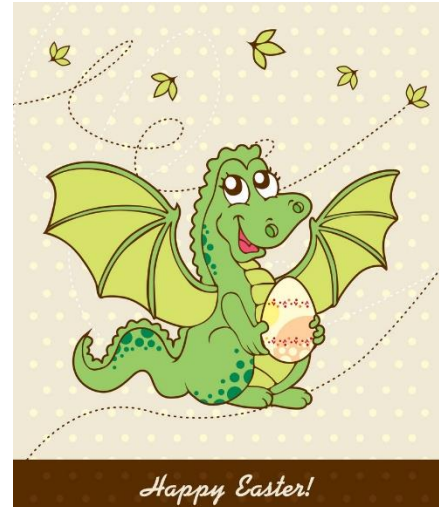


EGD EASTER QUIZ 2020
